#### **Health-Emotional**

 Isolation and Relationship breakdown/ Lack of support/ Discrimination



- Emotional Problem
- Antenatal & Postnatal depression

#### Child Care

- Lack of psychological preparation
- Lack of child care skills
- Lack of good modeling owing to unsecured attachment in family of origin and the poor relationship with their families.

- Less aware of baby's needs.
- Role Conflict/ No confidence in effective parenting (Birkeland, R, Thompson, J. K. & Phares, 2005.)

#### Financial

- Unemployed owing to low academic achievement and skills
- Poverty
- Poor housing/ nowhere to live



- Financial burden
- Limited resources, Limited choices

- 1.4 million Hong Kong dollars, targeting 80 teen mothers or pregnant girls who are under the age of 19



#### 1. Meaningful Identity

- 34 secured employment
